



## **First Nations Languages in British Columbia**

### **Version: February 28, 2025**

There are **36 First Nations languages** indigenous to British Columbia, belonging to **7 distinct language families** and encompassing at least **96 different dialects**. This document provides a list of these languages, including the following information:

- **LANGUAGE name.** Sometimes there isn't a single language name to cover all varieties of a language or a language is commonly known by more than one name. In these cases, the language name lists varieties with slashes in between such as *Xaad Kil / Xaayda Kil*.
- **FAMILY name.** Languages that are connected to each other through a common ancestor language belong to the same language family.
- **OTHER names** by which the language is known, today or in the past. Some of these names may no longer be in use and may not be considered acceptable by communities but it is useful to include them in order to assist with the location of language resources which may have used these alternate names.
- **DIALECT names.** Dialects are varieties of a language spoken in different communities. Each dialect has differences that make it unique. There might be differences in pronunciation, words, sentence structure or even in the meaning of certain words. But dialects of the same language are *mutually intelligible*. This means that speakers of one dialect can understand speakers of another dialect and vice versa. This is the main way to tell the difference between a dialect and a language. If speakers can understand each other, in spite of differences in their speech, they are speaking dialects of the same language. Some languages extend beyond B.C.'s borders; only dialects spoken in B.C. are included here. There may be variation in the spelling of dialect names and in the number of dialects for each language.
- **COMMUNITIES.** We include the main communities where a language is spoken but languages may also be spoken in other towns and cities across the province.

We know that before the beginning of colonization, speakers of First Nations languages in B.C. tended to be familiar with other dialects of their language and it was even common to be multilingual, speaking several different languages. We encourage people who share dialects of the same language to collaborate on language reclamation, revitalization and maintenance.

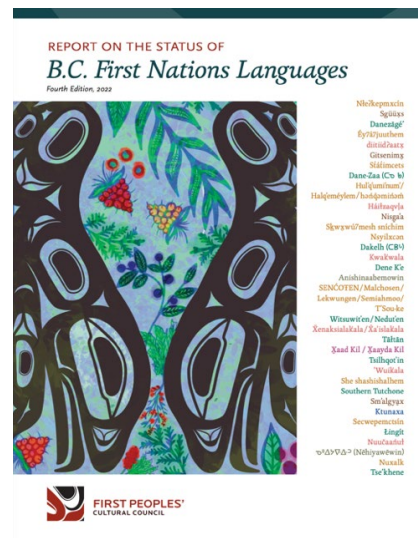
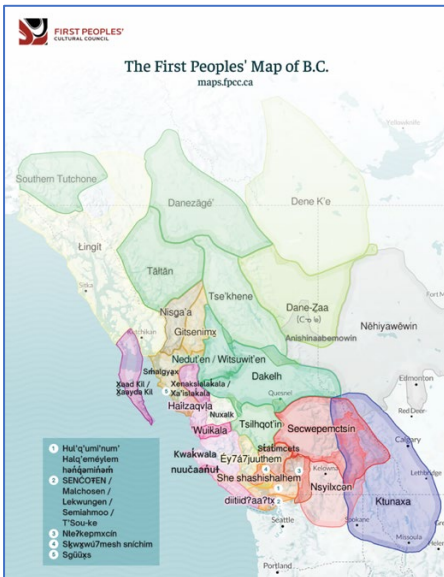
There are a few sleeping languages indigenous to B.C. that don't currently have any active speakers in B.C.: Nicola, Tāgizi Dene (Tagish or Den K'e) and Tsetsaut (Wetalh).

In addition to the languages listed here, there are also many other Indigenous languages from other places which are now spoken in B.C. including the languages of Inuit, Métis or other First Nations and Indigenous people. The trade language Chinuk Wawa (Chinook Jargon) was also spoken in B.C. in the past. To our knowledge there are no first language speakers of Chinuk Wawa in B.C. but there is an active community of learners.
